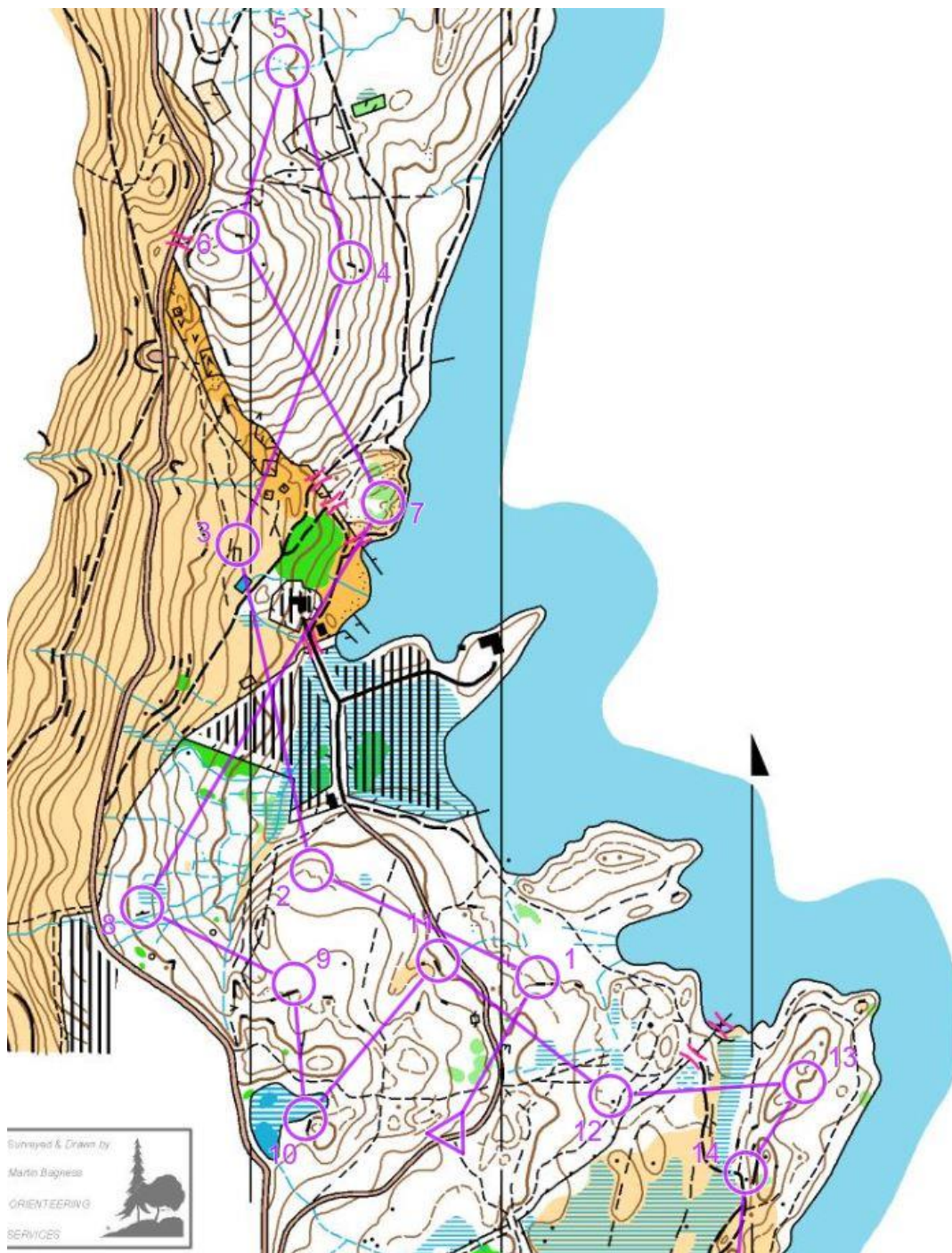

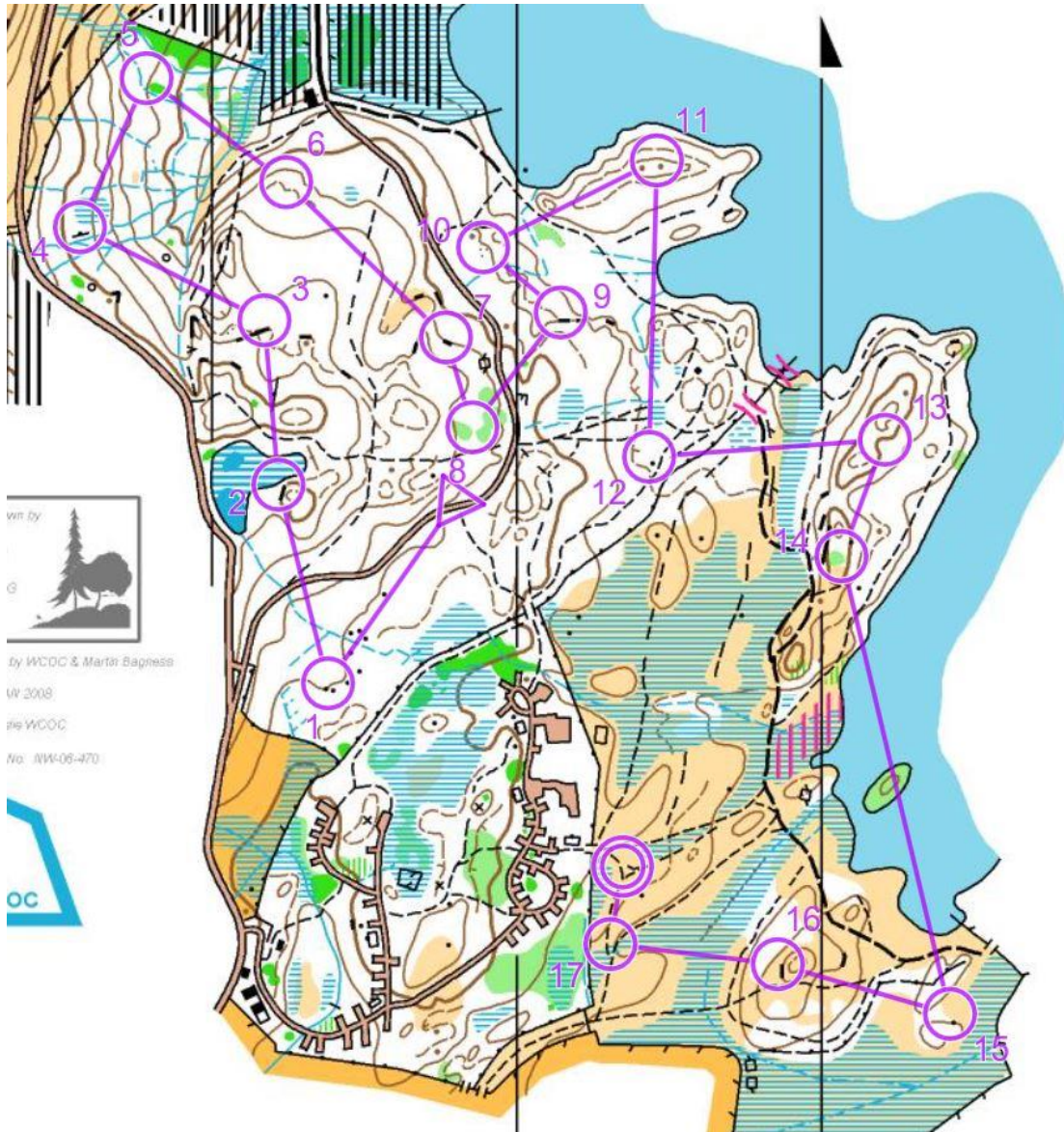
2011 Light Green

Lots of changes of direction – important to have good exit direction.

Note crossing points on walls – competition maps will have purple OOB along walls.

So #3 to #4 drop to crossing point, North East to path junction and then start climbing hill.

Think about contour shapes under paths – keep high on way South East to #9.



2011 Green

Again lots of changes of Direction. Keep looking at compass during legs.

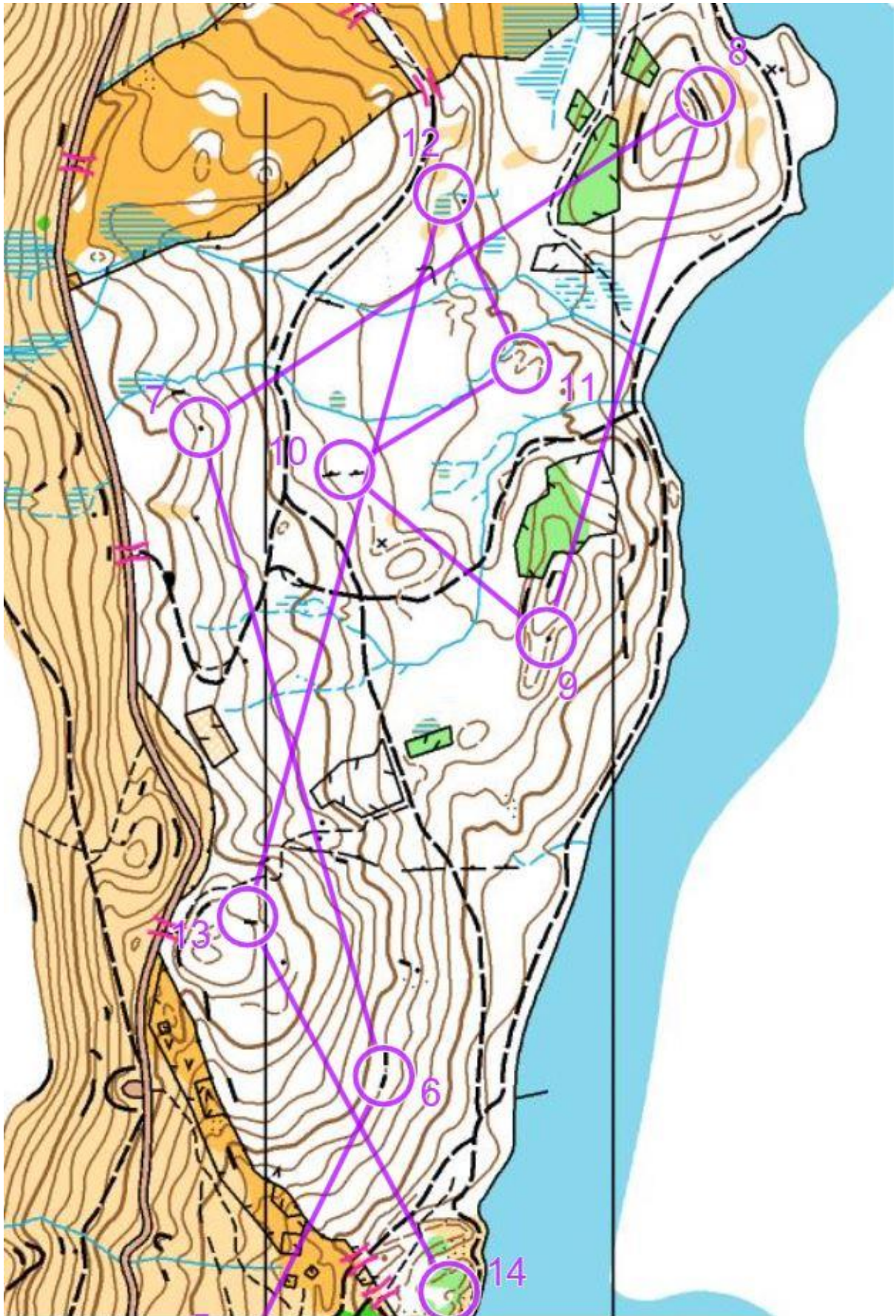
#1 possibly hardest control?

Exit #3 West and keep high on way to #4.

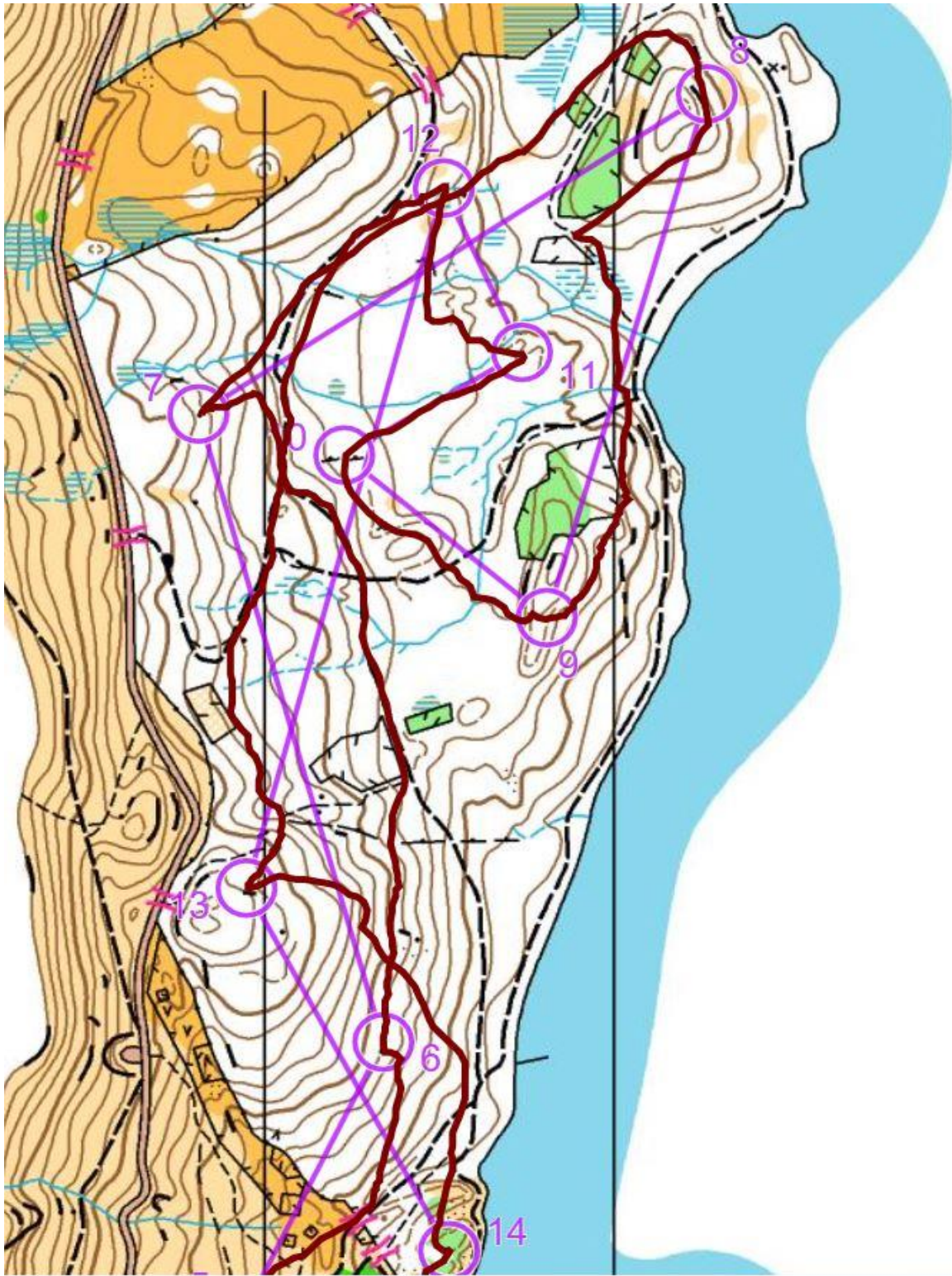
#5 to #6 looks to be direct.

#11 to #12 use paths or just compass due South and follow ditch to marsh & onto boulder?

#12 to #13 to crossing point then compass.



2011 Blue



2011 Blue – John Slater – Examples of poor Exit Direction.

#8 exit due South to find path – follow path over two streams and past small hill to east and crag to west – then start contouring up the slope.

#13 exit South East to find soft spur shape under red line and keep wall to South West. Descend to crossing point, climb small hill and drop to second crossing point as Attack Point.
